

Research Medical Library wins national award

[The Research Medical Library](#) earned the 2021 MLA Research Advancement in Health Sciences Librarianship Award.

This prestigious award is given by the [Medical Library Association](#) to recognize health sciences libraries that make outstanding contributions to advancing health information research and evidence-based practice.

Over the past 12 months, our library has demonstrated its excellence in many ways. Scientific editors have edited more than 800 manuscripts and 238 grants, totaling more than \$109 million in potential funding for our institution; our librarians have hosted [more than 400 consultations](#) to guide faculty, staff, and students on topics such as literature searching, writing, publishing, EndNote, resource access, the NIH Public Access Policy, and others.
