COVID-19 and Patients with
Cancer

The COVID-19 pandemic has changed cancer care for patients and placed oncologists on the front line of caring for those affected. In support of oncology research and patient care, our clinical librarian created a [special collection of articles, resources, and search strategies](#) focused on cancer care and COVID-19. [This collection](#) tracks up-to-date scientific information and is categorized by research area.

How do I use the collection?

The [COVID-19 and Cancer literature collection](#) is categorized by treatment type, cancer type, and services and specialties. The [cancer treatment tab](#) offers a one-click search for COVID-19 and cancer treatment, types including chemotherapy, immunotherapy, radiation therapy, stem cell transplantation, and surgery. A focused search, broad search, and access to the most recent articles are available for each treatment type.

Select the [Cancer Types tab](#) to view publications related to COVID-19 and specific cancers. Once a cancer type is selected, a new tab will open in PubMed and a search alert can be set up with NCBI.

The [Services and Specialties tab](#) includes advanced searches on COVID-19 and CT imaging, critical care, emergency care, palliative care, and telemedicine.

How does this collection help me?

These search strategies can be used to stay up to date on the latest information around COVID-19 and cancer. Authors can set up email alerts based on the strategies or incorporate them into a literature review for presentations or publications. In addition, the [MD Anderson Highlights tab](#) links to the latest COVID-19 research from MD Anderson authors.
