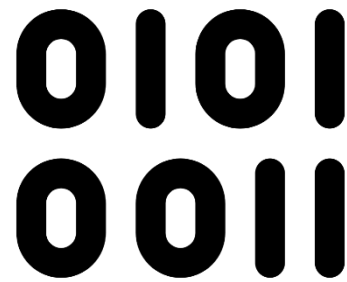

## Information for Emerging Clinical Issues

### Get a Quick Overview

When emerging public health issues arise, we are inundated with information from news outlets, social media, friends, family, and colleagues. So how do you find the right information for your clinical question, and fast? The library offers tools like [UpToDate](#) and [DynaMed](#) that provide a quick overview of a topic. Access these from your desktop or [download the apps](#) for your smartphone.

### Ask for More In-depth Information

What happens if your question is not answered in UpToDate or DynaMed? [Ask a librarian](#). Our librarians have experience searching for and finding information quickly. During Hurricane Harvey, we received requests for information on infection control for immunocompromised patients who were exposed to floodwater. Our expert librarians were able to locate and deliver the latest evidence to inform our clinicians. Request help with our [literature search request form](#), and be sure to let us know that this is an urgent request.

### Get Access Anytime, Anywhere

Access all of our full-text subscriptions anywhere, anytime with our LibKey Nomad tool for Google Chrome. [Download the app](#) for Chrome and look for the LibKey icon on your screen. LibKey will connect you to the full-text article if it's available. Can't find the PDF? Request any article, book, or book chapter through our free [Document Delivery service](#). We'll locate, purchase, and deliver any article within 72 hours.
